



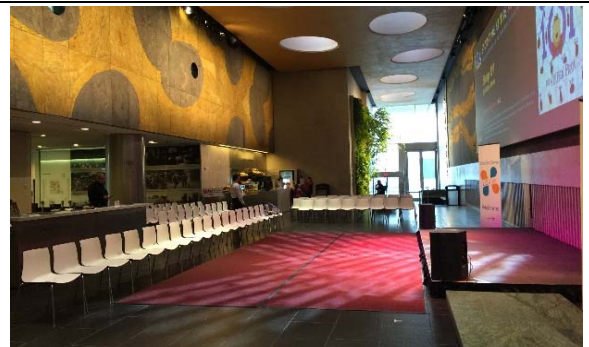
## I'm going to **Lincoln Center** with my family!

If I need **headphones**, I can borrow them from the staff.



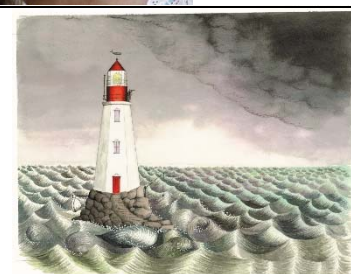
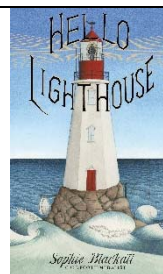
**Next**, we will meet Sophie Blackall. She is the author and illustrator of a book called *Hello Lighthouse*.
