

I'm going to **Lincoln Center** with my family!

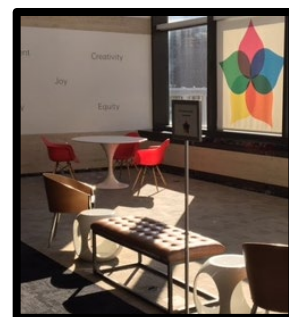
Lincoln Center is the largest performing arts center in the world and people come here from many different places to see concerts, plays, and dance.

First, I'm going to the **Rose Building** to pick up my ticket at the Passport table. If I need earplugs or headphones, I can borrow them.

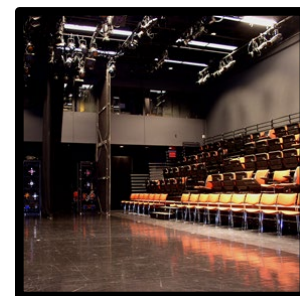


After I go through the turnstiles, I'll take the elevator to the Clark Studio Theater on the **7th Floor**.

Then, when the theater opens, I'll show the ushers my ticket. They will hand me a program and lead me inside.



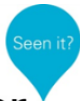

At the end of the performance, I will applaud with the audience to thank Mumu Fresh for the show!



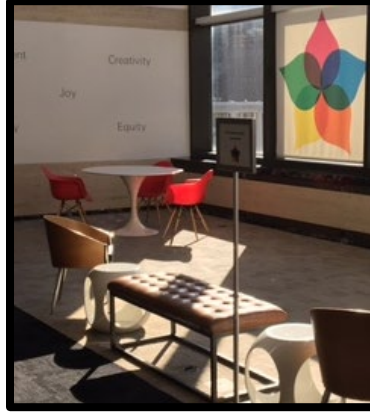

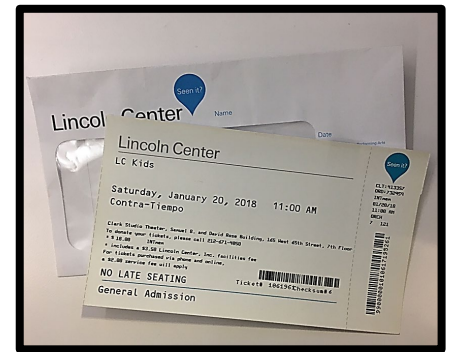

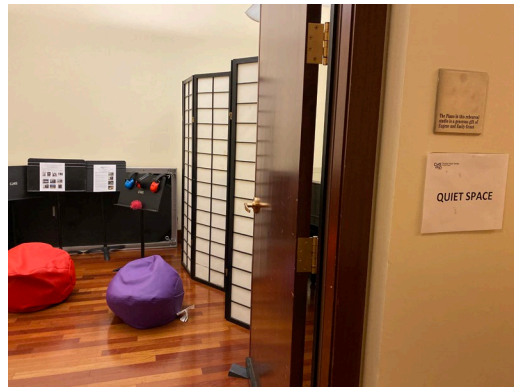
